Question 1. What are the names of the four spots to be marked on a Billiards table?

Four spots shall be marked on the centre longitudinal line of the table.

The Spot, located 12% ins. from the face of the top cushion.

The Pyramid Spot, located midway between the face of the top cushion and

The Centre Spot which itself is located midway between top and baulk cushions.

Question 2. What are the circumstances where rarely used spots are used in Billiards.

Section 3, 10 Limitation of hazards.

The Centre Baulk Spot, located on the Baulk line.

c) If the non-striker's ball is off the table as a result of the non-striker's last stroke, it shall be placed on the Middle of the Baulk-line after the fifteenth hazard or, if that is occupied, on the right-hand corner of the "D", viewed from the bottom of the table.
