

In the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the 1999 world championships Dominic Dale was drawn to play Nigel Bond.

During the course of this best of 19 frame match which was won 10 frames to 6 by Nigel, Dominic Dale set the world record for the highest total for one frame in a world ranking event when he finished one of the frames with a total of 167.

This was made up of a break of 122, one red and 11 fouls and misses worth 44 penalty points.
