In potting the first red the striker snookers himself on all the colours. He then nominates the Black and misses. The referee calls a foul and a miss and is asked by the non striker to replace the balls and have his opponent replay the stroke. The striker again nominates the Black and by fluke, pots it. He then goes on to make a total clearance taking a Black after each of the remaining fourteen Reds, thus making a break of 146 and starting that break with the black. The referee in calling the scores for the frame would state, "one", then "foul" (7), then, to start the break, "seven" and re-spot the black, then "eight", then "fifteen" and re-spot the black, etc. The eventual frame score would then be 147 - 7 comprising of a score of one, and a break of one hundred and forty six to the winner, and a seven point foul to his opponent.
