Jamie Burnett is the player who holds the record. In his qualifying match against Leo Fernandez in the 2004 U.K. Championships he made a break of 148. This was made up of a free ball brown after Leo had fouled before a ball had been potted. Jamie then took the brown as his nominated colour followed by all 15 reds and the colours taken after each of those reds being 12 blacks, 2 pinks and 1 blue. This was followed by all 6 colours in sequence to make up his record breaking 148.

Jamie Cope is credited with a maximum 155 by this means but it was in a practice match and does not count in official tournament play records.
